

Happy New Year! In the rush of Advent, Christmas and now Epiphany and New Year (football and now basketball games!) celebrations, I hope the beginning of this new year brings all of us a time to slow down and listen in – to God, to family and friends and to fellow congregation members.

My prayer for you and your family as we end this Advent and Christmas season and enter the



new year of 2025 is to continue to consider the hope and peace, which we discussed over Advent, that we have in Jesus Christ. Most of all, I want us to celebrate the new year by reflecting with gladness for a caring church family and thankfulness to God for a ministry here at Northwood that grows our faith in Christ and reaches out into our world and into the future as well.

The change will be that anyone, member or not, can be a part of our church committees, but the Deacon Moderator will have to be ordained and/or installed.

### Session Report - December 2024

At their December 17, 2024 meeting, Northwood Session Elders:

- 1. Approved the balanced 2024 General Fund Budget, the Pastor's compensation to be sent on to the Congregational Meeting, scheduled January 26, 2025, for the annual Congregational Meeting immediately following worship and the reminder that a 2/3 vote for Bylaw changes is needed with the change to make Deacons a committee;
- 2. The new budget also includes a 3 percent increase in minimum age;
- 3. Shared from Christian Ed. that the adult small group Bible study will continue to meet;
- 4. Approved Rev. Ted Mattie as preacher for December 29 but also as fill-in pastoral care with Rev. Katie Haney out of town in December;
- 5. Heard reports from all Session committees, the Deacons meeting in November and approved the November 2024 financial report.
