Note from the Pastor

You May Think I'm Only Here as a Fill-In, to Get You from Point A to Point B...

But, on the contrary, between the start of my Interim Ministry and the calling of your next, newly-installed pastor, my intentions are to do the following:

- 1. Invite you to wonder (with me) about the Love of God as revealed in Jesus of Nazareth, and to embody that love for you and among you "with fear and trembling..." (Philippians 2:12);
- 2. Celebrate the ministries of the past and present at Northwood Presbyterian... while also grieving interpersonal disappointments and losses;
- 3. Ask you—the members and friends of this community of faith—to imagine how you are perceived differently from the outsider's point of view;
- 4. Cultivate the curiosity and the imagination which positions Northwood Pres. on the cusp of the particular mission which God's Spirit has in store for the coming years;
- 5. Challenge you to slow down and savor the Abundant-Grace-Rhythms of God, who provides in times of wilderness-transition the prayerful sustenance needed to engage in neighborly and covenant relationships;
- 6. Train you to appreciate and to develop allies (perhaps non-Presbyterian, perhaps non-Christian) who may want to work alongside you in ministries to the most vulnerable;
- 7. Encourage you to offer mutual encouragement as well as honest, constructive feedback regarding words and behaviors which prompt toward encounters of authentic trust;
- 8. Teach you about the possibilities of a Transforming Presence in worship services which take courage in the face of passages like Jeremiah 7:4—"Do not trust in these deceptive words: 'This is the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord, the temple of the Lord...";
- 9. Promote the discipline of 'Lament' when confronted with profound despair and anxiety over institutional and cultural change; and
- 10. Learn from you about the Inscrutable Mystery of God in both our failures and our successes—which translates to lots of tears and laughter.


Community Garden
