He has been active in ministry in multiple different roles and most recently has been the interim pastor at Salem Lutheran Church here in Spokane. In addition, he currently serves as chaplain for. Gentiva hospice. Scott is married to Reverend Sheryl Kinder-Pyle the current executive Presbyter of the Presbytery of the Inland Northwest. They have two grown sons. While Scott is originally from the Philadelphia Pennsylvania area, both he and Sheryl have developed to love for the Pacific Northwest and Spokane area.
