TO: Northwood Pres. Elders, Deacons, Church Staff and Congregation,

I am writing to inform you that I will be retiring effective Sunday, August 10, 2025, after I turn 67 years old. I will, however, have my final Sunday, with two weeks of vacation, a little earlier on: Sunday, July 27, 2025.

While I look forward to enjoying my retirement, I have really appreciated this church family during my 15 years here as your Pastor and Head of Staff, especially the past 4-5 years, when it has been important for us to band together in our continuing Covid world! I also do not know, at this time, when I will have one more short medical leave this year -- as my neuro-surgeon's appointment (again!) is not until March 5.

If I can be of any assistance before my retirement, I would be happy to provide whatever help I can -- to provide a smooth transition for/to my successor! Attached to this document, for our Session elders, was our Presbytery of the Inland Northwest's (PIN) Parameters of Ethical Conduct guidelines for retiring installed pastors and congregations, which your Elders and I have agreed to! We have copies of that document for any of you who'd like to see it as we begin this process.

This summer, God willing, I do plan to downsize and sell my house and move back to Vancouver, WA/USA (where I was ordained). I hope to reconnect with Presbyterian churches there and to finish up on the waiting list for independent living at a retirement community. In the meantime, my prayers continue for all of us during these next 6 months, especially those of you who have just started or returned to Northwood Pres. during this past year or so!
